

General Information

History

John F. Savage Hall enters its 33rd year as the home of Rocket basketball, and its first since the completion of a \$30 million renovation that has made the University of Toledo athletic facility one of the finest arenas in the country. The renovation and expansion of Savage Arena and the adjoining Charles A. Sullivan Athletic Complex debuted in November. Originally known as Centennial Arena when it was built in 1976, the arena was renamed "Savage Hall" in1988 and then became "Savage Arena" this past year as part of the renovation project.

Designed by architectural firms of SSOE, Inc. and Ellerbe Becket, the new Savage Arena includes a new "bowl-style" seating configuration that will bring fans closer to the action. Seating capacity for basketball is 7,300. Among the other improvements to the arena are the addition of a suites, loges and club seats along the west side of the area a new jumbo video scoreboard and sound system; new lighting; new restrooms and concession stands; a remodeled Joe Grogan Room, a glass-enclosed lounge with seating for up to 200 dinner guests; new locker rooms and team rooms; and a new athletic training room, complete with two whirlpool and the latest in treatment and rehabilitation equipment.

Adjoining Savage Arena is the brand-new Sullivan Complex, a 36,000 square-foot building that serves as the perfect complement to the new arena. Highlighting the Sullivan Complex is the beautiful new glass atrium lobby that serves as the primary entrance into Savage Arena Other features include a new ticket office; the "RocketShop" for the sale of UT merchandise on game day and during normal business hours; a brand-new Varsity 'T' Hall of Fame; the Downtown Coaches "Wall of Champions"; a new 10,000 square-foot strength and training center for UT student-athletes; and new offices for coaches and staff.

A multi-purpose complex, Savage Arena not only serves the needs of intercollegiate athletics, but it also hosts concerts, convocations and graduation exercises To date, nearly eight million people have visited Savage Hall for various forms of entertainment.

The list of entertainers who have performed in Savage Arena include Elvis Presley, Cher, Pearl Jam Smashing Pumpkins, Kenny Chesney, Sheryl Crow, TLC, Boyz II Men, Elton John, Frank Sinatra, Michael Bolton Rod Stewart, Bob Seger, Steve Winwood and many others.



BY CAR

A) From the east (Cleveland) - Ohio Turnpike Exi 59;I-75 north to I-475 west, exit at Douglas Road; Turn left on Douglas and proceed to East Rocket Drive; right on East Rocket Drive into campus.

B) From the south (Dayton/Columbus) - I-75 North To I-475 west; exit at Douglas Road; turn left on Douglas and proceed to East Rocket Drive right on East Rocket Drive into campus.

C) From the North (Detroit/Ann Arbor) - (F Detroit) I-75 south to I-475 west, exit at Douglas Road; turn left on Douglas and proceed to East Rocket Drive, right on East Rocket Drive into campus. (From Ann Arbor) US-23 south to I-475 east, Exit at Secor Rd. and turn right on Secor, turn Left at Central Avenue; turn right on Douglas Road, Right on East Rocket Drive into campus.

D) From the west (Chicago) - Ohio Turnpike to Exit 64, Reynolds Road north to Dorr Street, right on Dorr; left at Douglas; right on East Rocket Drive into campus.

Ticketing

The University of Toledo Athletic and special ticket office is a fully functional computerized ticket operation located in the Charles A. Sullivan Complex of Savage Arena. Normal operating hours are Mon-Fri 8:30-5:00. Additional hours are available on weekends and evenings depending on scheduled events. The ticket office staff consists of 2 full time Ticket Operations Manager and 7-10 part time ticket sellers. The part time sellers are UT. acceptable forms of payment are cash, MC/VISA. We sell tickets for multiple events in Savage Arena and the Glass Bowl Stadium. Our current ticket software provider is Paciolan which is a full-feature in-house ticketing system
