PARKING MAP




TICKETING

TICKETMASTER:

No other ticketing company or third party can be used to sell tickets on behalf of the Licensee through outlets, internet, phone or otherwise. Ticketed events held at the BJCC Concert Hall will utilize Ticketmaster and be serviced by the BJCC Box Office staff including all applicable fees as set forth in the rental agreement.

BOX OFFICE:

The BJCC maintains a Central Ticket Office for daily in-person sales at Legacy Arena located at 1898 9th Ave. N, Birmingham, AL 35203. The BJCC Concert Hall box office, located directly adjacent to the Hall's main entrance, opens two hours prior to Concert Hall events.




INTERNET



CONCERT HALL DECK




STAGE FLOOR PLAN




SECOND FLOOR PLAN




BASEMENT CHORUS DRESSING ROOMS

POLICIES & GUIDELINES

The BJCC Concert Hall, as a facility within the Birmingham-Jefferson Convention Complex (BJCC) is owned and managed by the Birmingham-Jefferson Civic Center Authority.

While your Event Manager is available to clarify any specific policies and guidelines, some of our most referenced policies are listed below.

EVENT STAFFING:

The BJCC strives to maintain a friendly and safe environment for its guests. To achieve this level of service, minimum staffing levels are required for both ticketed and non-ticketed events that will be contracted for and supervised by the BJCC. Your Event Manager will work with you to determine the appropriate crowd management staffing model required to conduct a safe and secure event by evaluating event attendance, nature of event, show and venue history. Best Crowd Management is the exclusive provider of crowd management personnel. Fees for staffing are to be considered an event expense and the responsibility of the licensee.

PRODUCTION LABOR:

Licensee, working in coordination and direction of the BJCC, must use labor provided by International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees (IATSE) Local 78 for show-related rigging and production needs.

SIGNAGE:

Banners and signs are welcome in our facilities with advance approval from the BJCC. This includes, but is not limited to, exterior, interior, wayfinding, and entrance signage. Permanent facility signs and directional graphics may not be blocked. Signs must be placed on easels and not taped, tacked, or adhered to any other surface. Signage in the common spaces of the BJCC must be professionally printed or computer generated - no hand-written signs are permitted. Signs may not be placed in any complex elevator. Any damage by adhesive materials on floors, walls, or any BJCC property will incur charges. After an event, all posted signage must be removed, or a removal charge will be incurred.

SPONSORSHIPS:

All sponsorships including signage, giveaways and other promotional items displayed or handed out on the BJCC Concert Hall property must be coordinated with your Event Manager. Due to some building exclusivities, certain sponsors may be precluded from displays inside the BJCC Concert Hall and on building property. Please contact your Event Manager for the most up-to-date list of BJCC Concert Hall protected advertisers and partnerships.

FOOD & BEVERAGE:

All food and beverage to be consumed within the BJCC Concert Hall including catering, concessions, and alcohol service must be coordinated through the BJCC's exclusive partner, Sodexo Live!. Sodexo Live!, as the alcoholic beverage license holder, must enforce all applicable laws and codes in association with the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages and during activities serving alcoholic beverages, uniformed law enforcement officers, at the expense of licensee, must be on-site. Permission to distribute or dispense, without charge, samples of food, beverages, refreshments, sundries related to an event, etc. shall be arranged in advance and be clearly stated and identified as "further terms and conditions" to the Lease Agreement.

PYROTECHNICS:

All pyrotechnic effects must be approved by the BJCC and then permitted through Birmingham Fire and Rescue and State of Alabama as required. Birmingham Fire and Rescue's Fire Marshall division can be reached at (205) 250-7540 for any questions regarding the permitting processes, licenses, and fees required.

CONFETTI:

With advanced review and approval from the BJCC including the Director of Event Management, confetti may be used. Confetti should be made from a water-soluble paper source and be a minimum of 1" x 1" in size. Absolutely no mylar material or glitter shall be used in any confetti display. A minimum clean-up charge shall be assessed for the use of confetti.
